#### Case Studies

##### **Burrup Peninsula Rock Art Interpretive Centre Prefeasibility, 2008**

NBD in conjunction with Gresley Abas and Pracsys conducted market research, site assessment, and feasibility analysis and community consultation in order to determine the feasibility of a Rock Art Interpretive Centre on the Burrup Peninsula.



##### **Shire of Capel, Capel Sports Facility Community Consultation, 2008**

Two community workshops were convened to seek input to the planning and design of the Capel Sports Pavilion and then to determine community response to design options. NBD worked closely with Gresley Abas Architects to undertake this community consultation process and develop an optimum design framework.

### **Woodside Energy Ltd, Karratha Motel Prefeasibility, 2007**

NBD undertook a full prefeasibility analysis of a motel in Karratha for the local indigenous stakeholders (on behalf of Woodside Energy). Work involved market research, consultation and full financial modelling and presentation of findings in an interactive workshop to facilitate empowered community decision making.

### **Swan River Trust, 2007- 2008**

NBD researched the establishment of a fundraising Foundation to support the operations of the Swan River Trust and a community engagement membership program. This involved consultation with a range of volunteer groups working across Swan and Canning Rivers catchment to understand and develop an effective community engagement program which would complement existing programs and enhance wider WA public involvement in the conservation of the Rivers. The project has resulted in the establishment and launch of the River Guardians membership program.

The brief included extensive stakeholder involvement to ascertain community values regarding development at Ningaloo and Vlamingh Head.
